Each year the New Zealand Division of the Royal Aeronautical Society presents an all-day symposium on subjects of interest to the aviation community in New Zealand and the Pacific region. For the RNZAF, celebrating its 80th anniversary this year, we have the prospect of major decisions on its fleet replacement. We will also be hearing about the major acquisitions being made in Australia by the RAAF as it builds its warfighting capability

Airways is working with the aviation community and government as it embarks on a comprehensive update with the implementation of New Southern Sky. As well as major new investment, the aviation community is also seeing a change in approach to how it is regulated by the Civil Aviation Authority with, for example, the introduction of safety management systems.
